- ◆ Cinsault: 20%
- ◆ Mourvèdre: 10%

Location and Climate

Château de Lascaux is a 45 hectare family owned winery located in the *Pic Saint Loup* area of Languedoc in the foothills of the *Cevennes* mountains. Climate is mostly Mediterranean with very specific continental influences, especially during the grape maturation process.

Vineyards

Grapes come from several vineyards planted on a *garrigue* soil and surrounded by Aleppo pines and green oak trees. Organic farming certification process has been initiated for those lots in September 2006.

Winemaking and Ageing

Harvest is done by hand or is mechanized according to the lot, and entirely destalked and sorted. Traditional vinification at controlled temperature. Ageing in tanks during 7 months before bottling.
